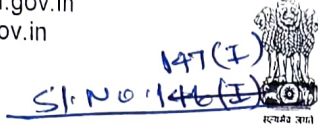

Question (a) The steps taken by the Government to modernise and green fisheries infrastructure through initiatives such as Eco-Fishing Ports, Smart Harbours, and the Blue Ports Initiative;

Reply: The concept of Eco Fishing Ports is similar to the Blue Port Initiative of Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nation (FAO). The Eco Fishing Ports are to implement a comprehensive set of interventions designed to modernize infrastructure, promote sustainability, and strengthen governance. The Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying has signed an agreement of Technical Cooperation Programme (TCP) with Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nation (FAO) for Strengthening of Blue Ports in India in March, 2025. Further, the Government of India had signed an agreement with French Development Bank (AFD) on Technical Cooperation between India and France on Blue Transformation of Fishing Harbors in December, 2024. These initiatives envisions development of more numbers of Smart and Integrated Fishing Harbours in conformity with the Blue Port Initiatives in future. As part of AFD's TCP Government of India has conducted a workshop on development of Eco Fishing Port in May, 2025.

Question (b) The number of fishing harbours and landing centres modernised with climate-resilient and digital infrastructure till date, State/UT-wise;

Question (c) The total funds allocated and utilised under these initiatives during the last five years, along with details of Central and externally aided projects, State/UT-wise.

Reply: No information available with this Institute.


Question (d) Whether the Government has collaborated with international agencies or banks for technical assistance, financing, or capacity building, and if so, the outcomes of such partnerships.

Reply: The Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying has collaborated a Technical Cooperation Programme (TCP) with Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nation (FAO) in March, 2025 for technical assistance and capacity building in developing smart, blue and integrated fishery harbours in the country.

Under the FAO's Blue Ports Initiative programme, a webinar was organized by FAO on "Sustainable Finance and Entrepreneurship" on 25th June, 2025.

Further, the Government also signed an agreement with French Development Bank (AFD) on Technical Cooperation between India and France on Blue Transformation of Fishing Harbors in December, 2024.

These initiatives would help in great way for developing sustainable fisheries sector particularly in development of fishery infrastructure in coming future.
