Question (a) Whether the Government has taken cognizance that only 287 out of the 1,547 notified Fish Landing Centres (FLCs) have been developed as Fishing Harbours since 1964, indicating only 18.5 percent are used;

Reply: Yes. However, it is to be noted that out of the total 1,547 notified marine Fish Landing Centres, development of infrastructure facilities at 379 locations (i.e. 24.5% of notified places) have been taken up and development of infrastructure facilities at the remaining 1,168 notified marine fish landing centres are taken up in phased manner.

Question (b) If so, the details of notified and developed FLCs, completion status, and reasons for slow progress hindering fisheries growth, State/UTs-wise;
