

Reproduced below is a provisionally admitted Lok Sabha Question Dy No. 12661 due for answer on 17.03.2026 regarding "Fish Landing Centres and KCCs".

- Whether the government has taken cognizance that only 287 out of the 1,547 notified Fish Landing Centres (FLCs) have been developed as Fishing Harbours since 1964, indicating only 18.5 percent are used;
- If so, the details of notified and developed FLCs, completion status, and reasons for slow progress hindering fisheries growth, State/UT-wise;
- the details of Kisan Credit Cards (KCC) issuance to fish farmers, including the loan amounts, State/UT-wise;
- whether the government has noticed the Standing Committee on Agriculture's observation that only 4.6 lakh KCCs have been issued to fish farmers out of around 2.8 crore fish farmers nationally, reflecting a meagre 1.6 percent coverage; and
- if so, the reasons for low penetration and the steps taken by the Government to cover all fish farmers?
