विषय /Sub: Rajya Sabha provisionally admitted Question Dy No.U1937 due for answer on 09.12.2025 regarding "Hejamadi Kodi Fishing Harbour project in Karnataka"- reg.

a) **Whether Government has approved development of Hejamadi Kodi Fishing Harbour project in Karnataka with an estimated cost of nearly Rs.140 Crores under Sagarmala Scheme?**

Reply: Yes.

b) **If so, details and present status of the project;**

Reply: Government of India, Department of Animal Husbandry, Dairying & Fisheries accorded administrative approval in August 2018 to the proposal of Government of Karnataka for development of existing fish landing centre at Hejamadi Kodi in Udupi District into a fishing harbour at a total cost not exceeding ₹13,860 lakhs under Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) on Blue Revolution in convergence mode of implementation by sharing the central grant between DADF (25%), the then Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare under CSS, Ministry of Shipping under Sagarmala programme (25%) and Government of Karnataka (50%).

The project was to be completed within a period of 3 years Present status of the project is not available with CICEF.

c) **Anticipated date by when the project is likely to be completed?**
